Rules and Procedures

Contest Date: March 26, 2011 Entry Fee: \$40.00
BBHS GYM

- Contest is open to girls between the ages of 7 and 10 years.
- Contestant must live in the Breaux Bridge High School District and attend a public school in the BBHS District or a private/parochial school while living in the BBHS District.
- Entry fee of \$40.00** (includes a 5x7 photograph).
- You must include a **wallet size photograph** (for newspaper and interview) with your entry fee and form.
- Contestants will be judged in Interview (Speaking Ability, Appearance, & Personality) and On Stage (Introduction Speech, Appearance, & Poise).
- Introduction Speech should not be longer than 30 seconds.
- Dress Code is Sunday best. (Long dresses, gloves, pageant wear, sandals, flip flops, and makeup are not allowed.
- Judges are aware of rules and regulations and their decision is final.
- Scores will not be posted or mailed out at a later date.
- Interview will be conducted prior to pageant. Time to be announced after deadline. Contestants are to be dropped off for interview.
- Pageant starts at 4:00 PM.
- Cover at door: \$5.00 for Adults and children 12 and older; all others free.**

Contestants will be invited to attend an Ice Cream Party honoring the 2010 Jr Crawfish Queen, Miss Marley Blanchard, on Friday, March 25, 2011 at 6:30 pm at the Breaux Bridge High School Gym.

The contestant chosen to reign as the 2011 Junior Crawfish Queen will be presented at the Sr. Queen Coronation Ball on April 23, 2011. She is expected to attend all functions that she is invited to and **she will not be allowed to compete for another title during her reign.** She and her parents/guardians will be required to sign a contract (copy attached).

2011 JUNIOR CRAWFISH QUEEN CONTRACT

1. You must agree that the B.B.C.F.A. has precedence over any other title. It can be the only title represented at a function or festival.
2. You must receive approval before representing this title at any function not mentioned below. Due to the amount of traveling that our royalty has been doing, it is up to each mother to keep in touch with the pageant director.
3. If you want to attend a parade, pageant or festival not listed below, you must contact the person in charge with that function to get an invitation. Once you receive your invitation, you must contact your director to inform us that you will be representing the B.B.C.F.A. at that particular function. All events must be approved by the respective committee chairman.
4. You cannot run for any other title during your reign.
5. You must be on your best behavior at all events while representing the B.B.C.F.A.
6. You must attend the following events as the 2011 Junior Crawfish Queen:

 - Crawfish Queen Functions (3 events: Social, Tea, Pageant April 22-23, 2011)
 - Crawfish Festival Official Poster Unveiling in April

 - Festival Mass – May 1, 2011
 - TV appearances representing Crawfish Festival week
 - All festival related events held festival weekend

 - Breaux Bridge Christmas Parade
 - Breaux Bridge Food Net
